



Your future Apprenticeship

DAF trains parts advisors to develop in depth product technical knowledge and customer service skills.



You will study and learn through a blended training programme consisting of virtual group sessions, online self-study, and workplace activities.

You will gain theoretical and practical skills with an emphasis on the understanding of stock management procedures and improving sales.



Apprentices will also be trained in a simulated Service Reception and Parts Department consisting of goods inward and counter areas.

The facility has dedicated computer facilities for on-line exercises that reflect an operational Service and Parts Department.



Throughout your Apprenticeship, you are supported by a dedicated Skills Coach, who will regularly visit you in the workplace to monitor your progress, training needs and support with your portfolio work.
